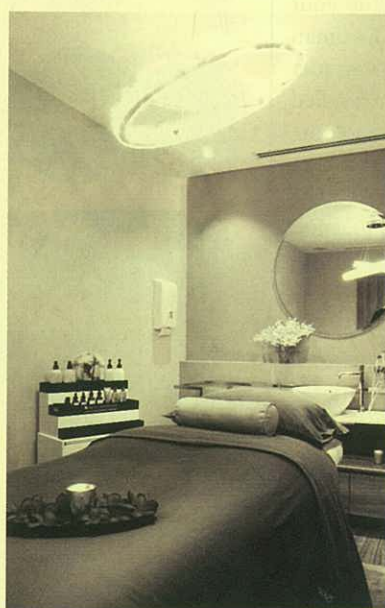


## SPRAY, DON'T STRAY
